	With the rapid emergence of cloud computing technologies, users are facing new risks, beyond the usual concerns of traditional IT security, caused by the external aspects of the cloud model. Cloud computing based on "Platform-as-a- Service" (PaaS) or "Software-as-a-Service" (SaaS) metaphors, presents additional technological challenges in the areas of data integrity, recovery, and tenant isolation, as well as additional legal challenges, including data auditing and regulatory compliance.
